We have also received the following details from Rhiannon Evans in the Welsh Government office in Ireland about plans for celebrating Wales Week 2020 in Dublin.

Wales week - 2-6 March 2020

The Wales week initiative was founded in 2017 by Dan Langford and Mike Jordan. It began as Wales Week London, their vision was to coordinate the promotion of activities and events delivered by a range of people and organisations in London around the time of St David's Day.

They approached a number of London based Welsh diaspora communities, clubs and societies to create a programme of events. In 2017 the programme had 50 events listed, this has significantly grown since and in 2019 there were 107 activities and events held during Wales Week London — with nearly 10,000 visitors and attendees. The Welsh Government has also organised a number of events as part of WW London.

The Welsh Government is supporting this initiative worldwide with a Wales Week being held in cities such as Paris and Berlin where there is government representation, as well as across the USA.

Our presence here in Ireland has been growing since 2017 and we intend to support a Wales Week Dublin between 02-06 March 2020. To do so we will be organising a number of activities including the usual formal, invitation only, St David's Day reception and badging them under the Wales Week banner. We have agreed to use their logo to brand our WG activity.

We are currently in the process of scoping potential venues and identifying partners for our programme of events but hope to work with a range of sectors including; culture, science and innovation and education.
